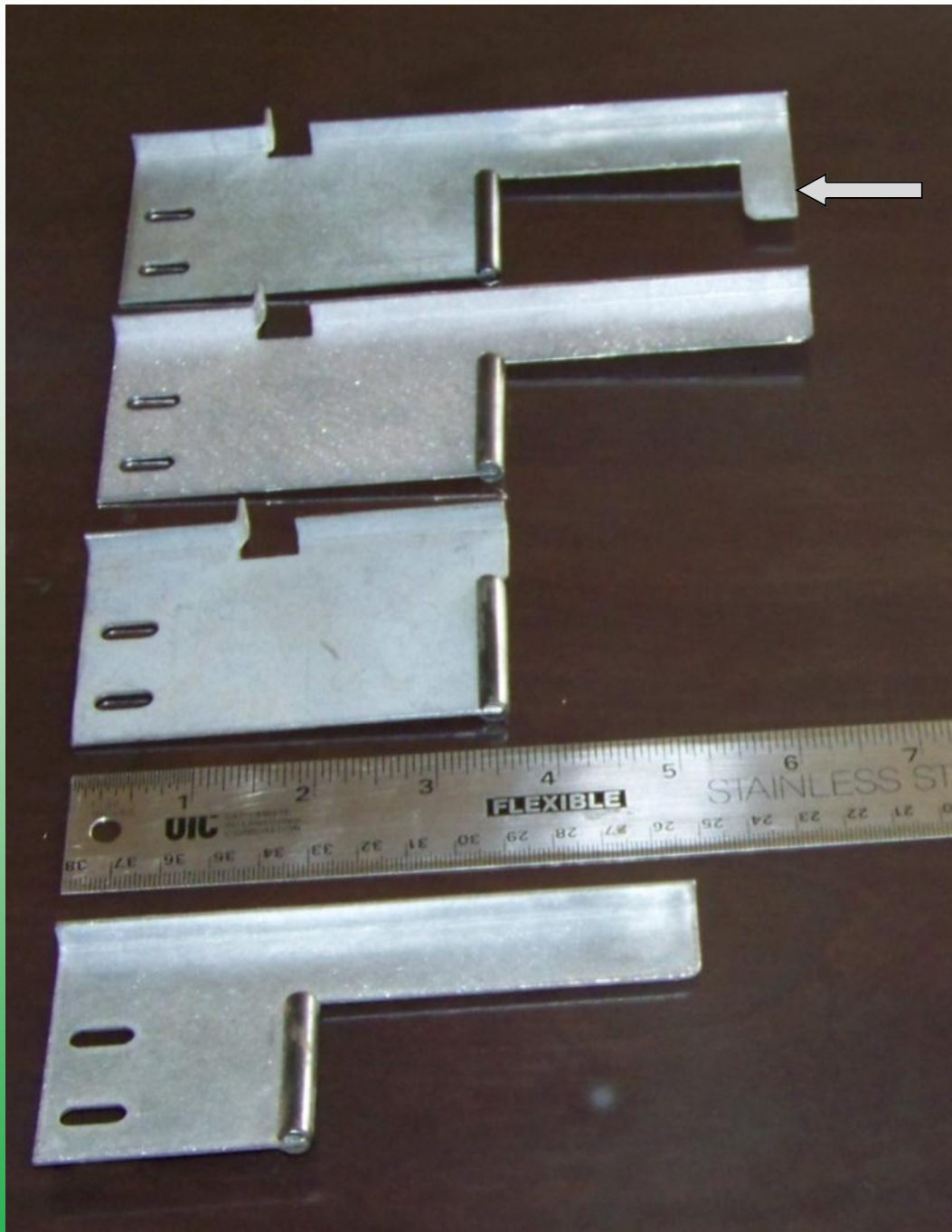


# VALLEY Talks about Push Chute Extensions



## [20900044](#)—EXTINCT— NO LONGER AVAILABLE

Tables from 1986's model ZD-4 used this extension, but when we introduced the DBA Great 8 we found the little L shape went right where the motor cable wanted to go. All this L does is pull the Ball Trap back down if your \$2 Hinge Bar spring breaks. It was a lot less trouble to stock only one Push Chute end and have operators make sure their spring isn't broken.

Tables since 2002's Valley Great 8 use this extension, even the current Panthers on our production line. Click this box to order it.

## [20900047](#)—THE EXPERIMENT

We thought about using a push chute end that fit in a smaller coin box, but it never panned out. Now we have a few left in stock and are selling them at a discounted price. You can see from the photo comparison the hardened steel roll pin and counter spring flange are where they need to be, but it looks pretty weird. Click this box to order it.
